#### **DESCRIPTION:**

A water-based product for re-waterproofing canvas goods. Also poly-cotton. (previously known as Gourocks or Birkmyres)

#### **APPLICATION AREAS:**

Designed for waterproofing of canvas products.

(Other materials should be carefully tested for its suitability; e.g. nylon, polyester or other synthetics).

#### **SURFACE PREPARATION:**

Make sure the surface to be re-sealed is clean and free of mildew etc.

Clean without soap or chemicals.

Do a test area prior to commencing.

# **APPLICATION:**

- Apply with a brush, swabbing or roller.
- Excessive thick coats are not advantageous.
- Allow to dry between coats.

- Apply thin coats.
- Avoid brush or roller marks.
- Apply two coats normally.
